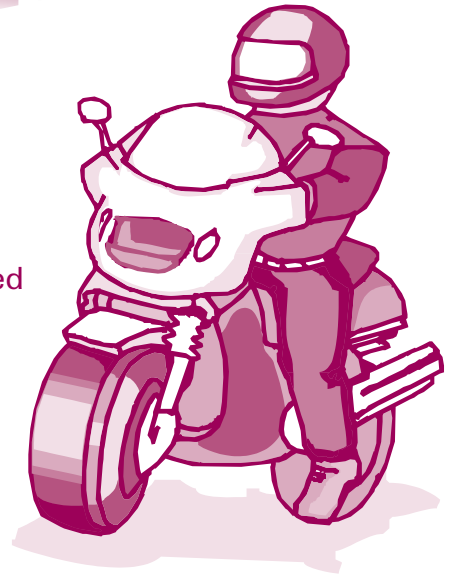


# Chevington Beat Newsletter

Since then Paul Dent and the Chevington beat team have been working to catch the culprits. Last month Paul identified a nuisance scooter rider and the youngster was issued with a Section 59 notice and his parents were informed. A further breach of the Section will lead to confiscation of the scooter.



## 36 Speeding Convictions

Safe speed enforcement on the Red Row Broomhill main road has been successful in calming traffic speeds and catching offenders. Ongoing enforcement has so far resulted in 36 drivers being fined and having 3 points put on licences.

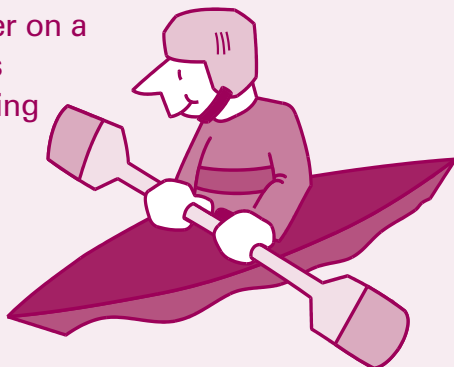
