In our recent consultation the community identified Hadston Precinct, Police Visibility and Contact and Youth Disorder as their top priorities. Here are some new initiatives to get to grips with some of these concerns.



Precinct - Graffiti Wipe out !

Grainger, the Coop and Northumberland County Council Community Wardens have teamed up to get on top of graffiti around the precinct.

Grainger have purchased a graffiti removal system that can be used by local shops and community groups to remove small scale graffiti around the precinct.

Visibility - Community Wardens and Police Support Officers

New faces keeping you safe - Northumbria Police have allocated 3 Police Community Support Officers to Castle Morpeth. Northumberland County Council have recently created a team of community wardens to work in priority areas across the county. These new faces will be around Hadston and Chevington from time to time assisting the police and council to keep the area safe, clean and friendly.
