

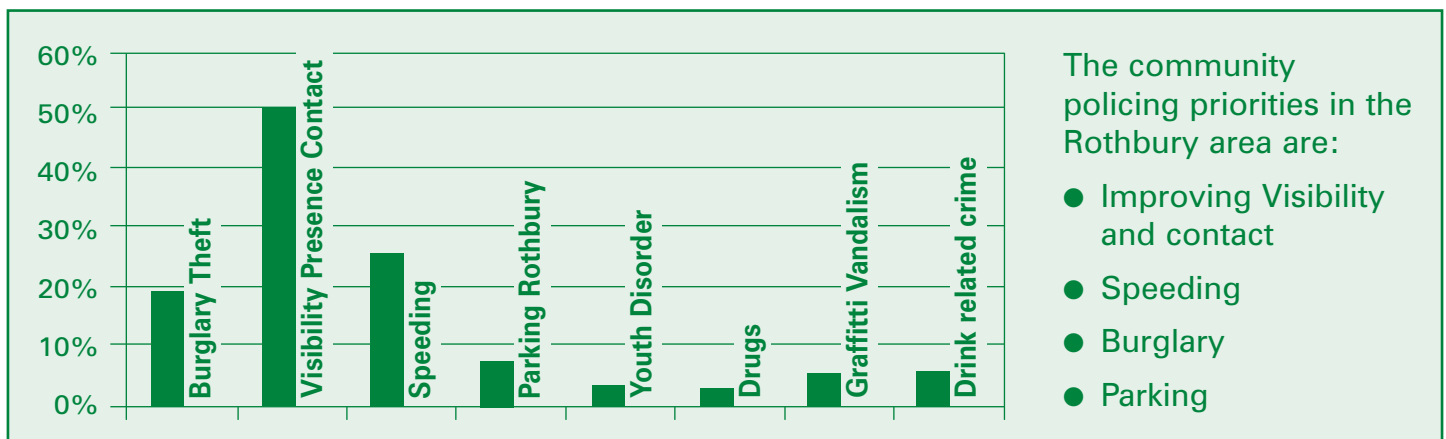
# Rothbury Beat Feedback

## Consultation Results

The Rothbury Beat team conducted a consultation across parishes in the Rothbury Beat area to identify community policing priorities.

**ACTION PLAN:** To address these priorities the community beat team, local parishes and the Rothbury Crime and Disorder forum have action planned some outcomes.

### Improving Visibility and Contact

- Establish and publicise a non emergency Rothbury Beat voicemail number: **01661 861355**
- Install non emergency police contact boxes in post offices and rural village halls
- Publicise and promote the names and faces of local Rothbury Beat officers
- Set up regular police contact with local schools parish clerks and post offices

### Speeding

- Train the Rothbury beat Team in the use of portable speeding detection equipment
- Undertake targeted speeding enforcement at sites on the A696 and Rothbury Road
- Undertake special summer operations to educate and deter motorcyclists from speeding eg. Operation Fireblade

- Feedback on enforcement and operation success to Rothbury Public Crime and Disorder Forum

### Burglary

- Undertake regular crime pattern analysis to identify any trends
- Undertake special operations at key periods and areas
- Undertake regular special operations with farmers to catch travelling criminals
- Publicise and feedback success

### Rothbury Parking

- Police Beat team to organise a meeting of key agencies and partners to review parking in Rothbury
- Feedback results of meeting to the Rothbury Public Crime and Disorder Forum
